# **YETI CUP 7 A-SIDE FOOTBALL TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS**

## **1. TOURNAMENT**

The tournament is called '**YETI CUP 7 A-SIDE FOOTBALL TOURNAMENT**' and games will be played following the rules and regulations of FIFA.

## **2. FORMAT**

- Knockout rule applies
- Teams will be divided into groups

## **3. TIMING**

- A. Full time –20 minutes
- B. Each half-10 minutes
- C. Interval-2 minutes

## **4. OFFSIDE RULE**

There are no offside rules in this tournament.

## **NUMBER OF PLAYERS**

- A. Full team –7 Players
- B. Reserves- 2 Players

## **MATCH POINTS**

- A. Win- 3pts
- B. Draw –1pts
- C. Loss –0 pts

## **5. LEAGUE POSITION DECIDER**

- A. Highest pts
- B. Higher goal difference
- C. Higher goals scored
- D. Best of 3 penalty kicks to decide the winner

## **6. SEMI –FINALS AND FINAL**

- A. Semi – finalists criteria will be decided later and informed to all.
- B. If the score is drawn, 3 penalty kicks taken by each team will decide the game.

## **7. PROTEST**

**NO PROTEST WILL BE ENTERTAINED. REFEREE'S DECISION IS FINAL.**

## **8. TEAM COLOURS**

A. All the teams must wear jerseys with numbers.

B. In any case of **COLOURS** clashes, the team winning the **TOSS** will have the choice to change or not to change.

C. The organising committee will provide a different colour kit for the losing team in the toss.
